


# FLAG SERIES

The label shows the origin as the main character and reflects a dedication to transparency, offering a deep dive into the technical specifications of the liquid, including precise maturation timelines and cask details.

Located in the Ahafo region of Western Ghana, this family-owned distillery is renowned historically for the production of cashew distillate. Years ago they began focusing on a local variety of organic sugar cane and started distilling using the fresh cane juice. After a fermentation of three days, distillation happens in a 2000L pot still. This bottling has been aged for one year in Ghana and three years of in Europe in ex bourbon cask. This cask strength rum represents one of the first and most interesting African rum on the markets: a rising star.

## TASTING NOTES

**Nose:** Expressive and vibrant. Cane juice and ripe pineapple shine, joined by notes of lime zest and green banana. With time, floral hints of jasmine and honeysuckle unfold, mingling with subtle touches of vanilla and toasted oak.

**Palate:** Dry, yet generous. Fresh sugarcane, passion fruit followed by layers of mango, citrus peel and honey. Vegetal tension balances the tropical sweetness, while light tannins from the oak add structure and depth.

**Finish:** Long and elegant. Spicy and slightly saline, it lingers on notes of candied citrus, chamomile and cocoa nibs. A final echo of cane and dried pineapple leaves a long and elegant finish
