

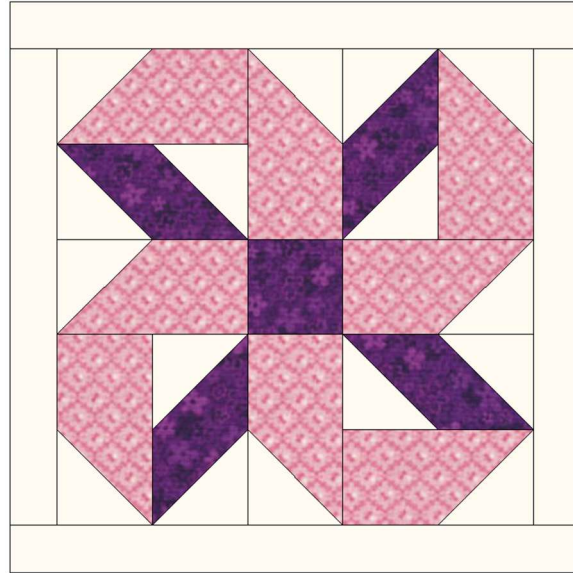


## Free Pattern

### Twisting Ribbon Star Quilt Block

Finished Block Size: 6" x 6"

Skill Level: Confident Beginner



#### What You'll Need:

- 2 contrasting fabrics (Check out this beautiful [Kansas Troubles Fat Quarter Bundle by Moda!](#))
- Background fabric (solid or subtle tone-on-tone)
- Rotary cutter and cutting mat ([my favorite here](#))
- Quilter's ruler ([I use this one daily](#))
- 1/4" foot or guide tape
- An iron and pressing mat

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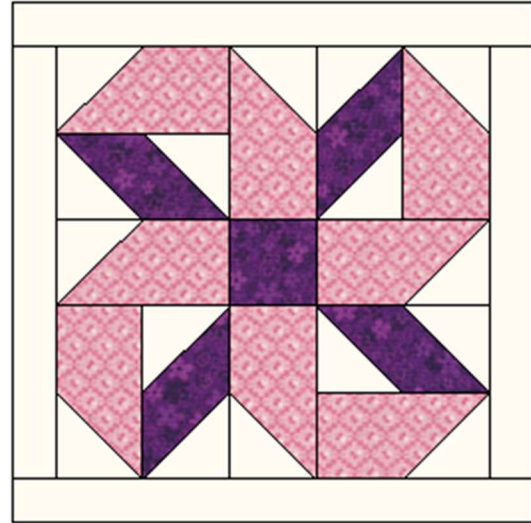
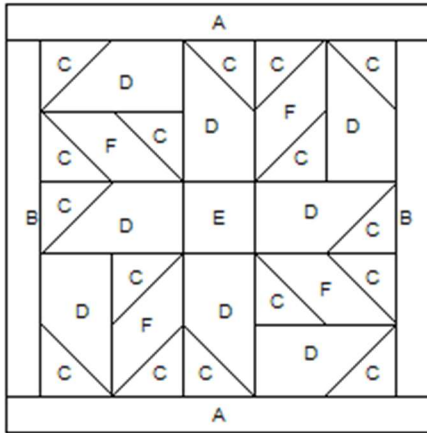

#### ✦ Cutting Instructions (for one 6" or 12" block)

#### Ribbon - FabricStacks

Key Block (41/100 actual size)

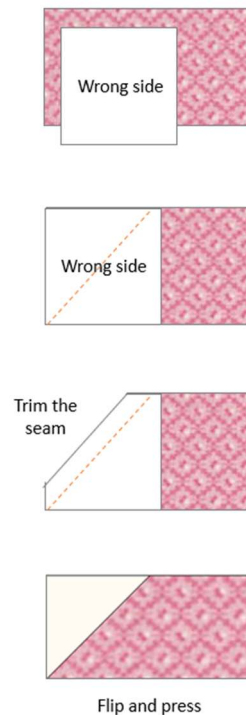


	Fabric	Size (cut) for 6" x 6" block	Size (cut) for 12" x 12" block	Quantity
A	Background	1" x 6.5"	1.5" x 12.5"	2
B	Background	1" x 5.5"	1.5" x 10.5"	2
C	Background	1.5" x 1.5"	2.5" x 2.5"	16
D	Medium	1.5" x 2.5"	2.5" x 4.5"	8
E	Dark	1.5" x 1.5"	2.5" x 2.5"	1
F	Dark	1.5" x 2.5"	2.5" x 4.5"	4

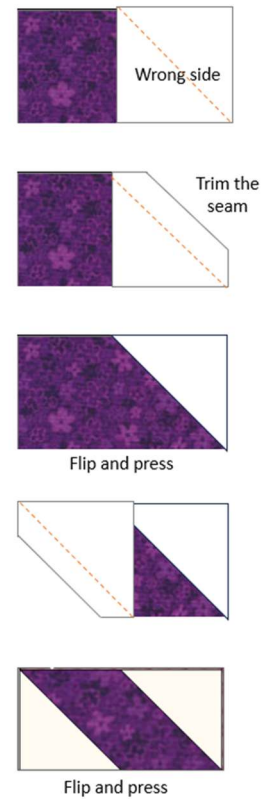
 **Step-by-Step Instructions:**

- This block uses the Stitch-and-Flip technique — be sure to check your alignment before trimming the seam.
- Check orientation carefully — the ribbons should spiral around the center!
- A precise 1/4" seam is key to matching the angles—sew accurately and press after each seam.

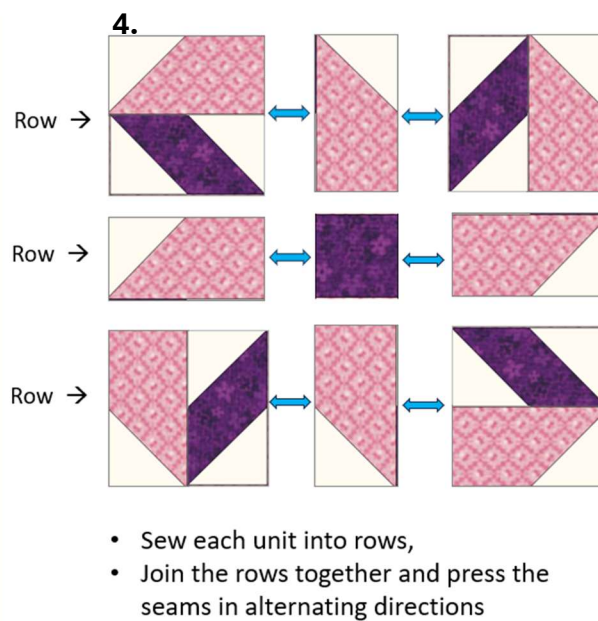
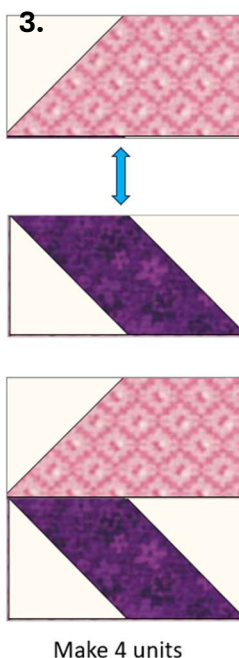
**1. Make 8 units**



**2. Make 4 units**



\*\*For the darker unit, press both seams toward the rectangle.

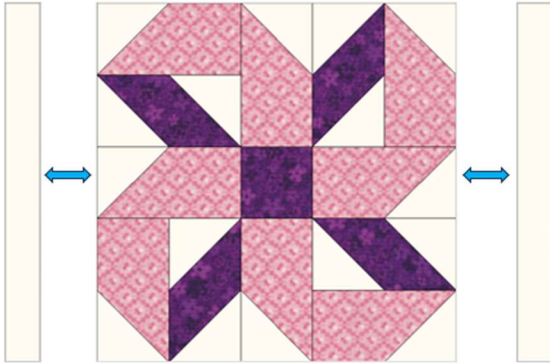

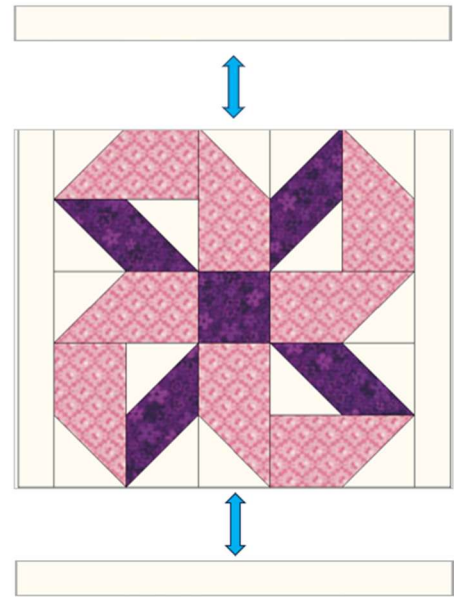
## ✂ Twisting Ribbon Star Quilt Block

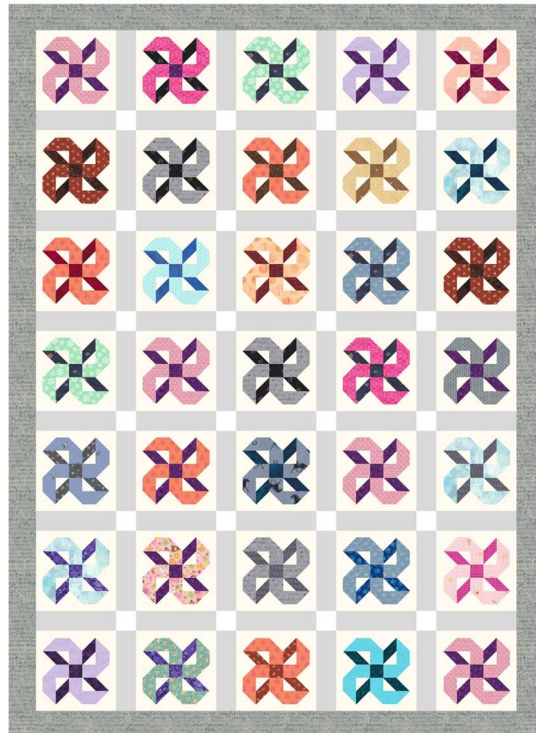
Add left and right borders to the unit,  
then top and bottom

\*\*If you'd like a slightly larger block, enlarge the border. For a finished size of 8", cut the borders to (2) 1.5" x 5.5" and (2) 1.5" x 8.5".

\*\*This example quilt layout for 6" square block, measures approximately 44" x 55". You'll need about 1.5 yards of fabric for the background, 5/8 yard for the sashing, and 1/2 yard for the border.

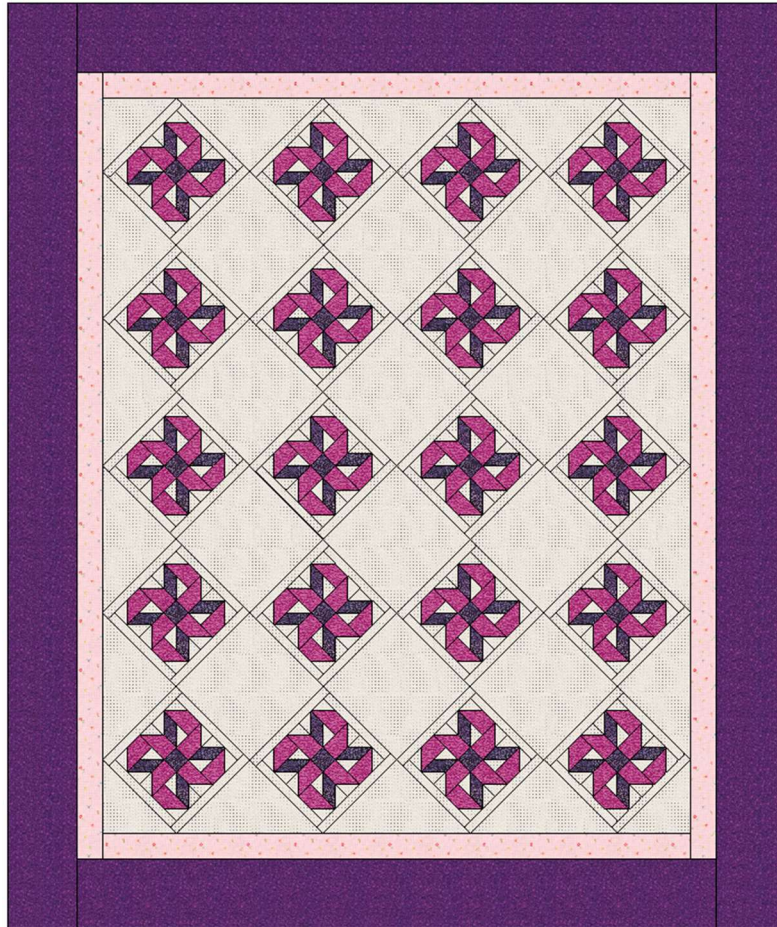




## Free Pattern

### Twisting Ribbon Star Quilt Block

This example quilt layout for 12" square block, measures approximately 90"x 106".



You'll need 4.5 yard for a background, 1.5 yard for medium color fabric, 5/8 yard for dark fabric, 1 yard for first border and 2 5/8 yard for 2<sup>nd</sup> border.

### Cutting

#### 1. Corner Triangles (4 needed):

Cut two 10" squares, then cut each square once diagonally to make 4 corner triangles.

#### 2. Side Triangles (14 needed):

Cut four 18.5" squares, then cut each square diagonally twice (an "X" cut). This will give you 16 side triangles—use only 14 of them.

#### 3. Background square

Cut twelve 12.5" square



## Free Pattern

### Twisting Ribbon Star Quilt Block

#### Lay Out Your Blocks

- Arrange the blocks on point—diagonally in rows.
- Fill in the sides with side triangles.
- Add the corner triangles in the four corners.

#### Sew Diagonal Rows

- Sew rows diagonally from left to right.
- Press seams carefully and match points.

#### Trim the Quilt Top

Once everything is assembled, trim the outer edges if needed.

#### Add Borders

You can now add first then second borders around the on-point layout to frame it.
